

# **Project Management Advisory Committee (PMAC)**

## **Terms of Reference**

### **Function**

The function of the PMAC is to –

- Influence the strategic direction of project and portfolio management at a whole-of-government level, through the provision of considered and expert advice to both the Inter Agency Steering Committee (IASC) and the Inter Agency Policy and Projects Unit (IAPPU).
- Provide advocacy for better practice project management.

### **Role**

The role of the PMAC is to -

- Support the strategic agenda of the IASC in relation to project and portfolio management and associated priorities.
- Provide strategic advice and recommendations to the IASC and IAPPU in relation to project and portfolio management from a whole-of-government level and agency perspective.
- Take on responsibility as a defined project or activity-specific reference group or working party as required by the IASC or IAPPU.
- Advise on, participate in and foster the continuous improvement of the Tasmanian Government Project Management Framework through IAPPU's work plan.
- Cultivate cross-agency awareness, linkages and improvement in project and portfolio management practices in the Tasmanian State Service.

### **Responsibilities of PMAC individual members**

- Represent their respective agency in all PMAC activity.
- Undertake activity as defined by the IASC/IAPPU.
- Undertake activity as defined by IAPPU in its work plan for the TGPMF.
- Promote and provide advocacy for professional development and better practice project and portfolio management within the Tasmanian State Service and the broader project management community.
