Media Protocols for Members of the Tasmanian Infrastructure Advisory Council (TIAC)

As the Tasmanian Infrastructure Advisory Council (TIAC) has been established to provide advice to Government and make recommendations and/or develop solutions to co-ordinate and integrate infrastructure provision in Tasmania, normal Government and media protocols should apply.

DIER is the central point for TIAC media contact. Corporate Affairs will coordinate responses to all media enquiries and contact Chair as appropriate.

The Minister will be consulted for any media events. If the Minister cannot attend then the **Chair of TIAC** is offered the option, and if not available Corporate Affairs will arrange a representative.

The Chair of TIAC should refer all media enquiries back to DIER's Corporate Affairs branch.

Government Members of TIAC must follow normal Government and media protocols, with DIER being the central point for all TIAC media contact.

Non-Government Members of TIAC may comment on matters relating directly to their business, but must not disclose matters discussed at TIAC that are either confidential, commercial in confidence or publish the opinions and views of other Council members.
