These activities are for young people in the Huon Valley and is fully supervised by qualified staff.

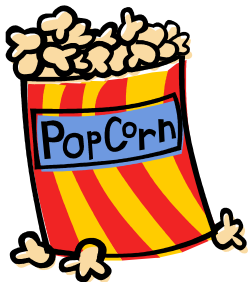
Teenage Holiday Activities
