

# ELECTRICITY REFORM OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

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## STATUS REPORT

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**Date: 26 April 2013**

The Electricity Reform Oversight Committee met on 24 April 2013.

The following matters were discussed:

- status of the project work streams;
- project risks and issues; and
- reports from the various working groups.

The Electricity Reform Oversight Committee noted that the Electricity Reform (Implementation) Bill 2013 has been passed by both Houses of Parliament.

The Electricity Reform Oversight Committee:

- considered advice from Hydro Tasmania and Concept Consulting regarding the resolution of a number of technical issues relating to the methodology for the regulated wholesale contract pricing and agreed to a number of clarifications to be included in the Minister's initial wholesale contract regulatory instrument;
- noted advice from the Business Transition Group on the potential future use of Aurora's customer care and billing system for Momentum Energy;
- noted that a situation analysis on people and cultural integration will be provided to the Network Integration Transition Board for consideration; and
- considered the proposed composition of the two mass market retail customer bundles.
